All courses to be certified must be required for my approved degree in order to receive VA benefits. Courses that do not apply to my degree or minor program, or count as an elective needed for the degree program, will not be certified and will not count toward the number of credits required for full-time status. Avocational/Recreational courses cannot be certified unless specifically required for my degree program. (Examples include voice lessons, instrumental courses, physical education courses, etc.)

Courses taken as an audit cannot be certified. If the grade option is changed to Audit during the course of the semester the VA certification will be amended. This may result in a debt to the VA, Washington University, or both.

Withdrawal or schedule changes could result in student debts to the VA, Washington University, or both.

Satisfactory Progress Standards must be met to continue to be eligible for VA educational benefits.

Benefits from the VA may vary from term to term and within a term based on student enrollment.

Classes that do not meet for the entire semester are only certified for the period in which they meet. The VA will exclude them during the rest of the semester when calculating your benefit. This can impact the BAH for Chapter 33.

I am responsible for reporting any and all changes in enrollment and/or major to the VA School Certifying Official immediately.

If the US Dept. of Veteran Affairs alters/cancels my benefits and/or eligibility status resulting in a change of benefits percentage payment rate, or if my benefits are exhausted, I am responsible for full payment of valid payments of tuition and fee charges due the school.

Correspondence from the VA School Certifying Official will be sent via email using my <u>University</u> <u>assigned email address</u>. I am responsible for reading and responding to those emails in a timely manner.
